MSPB POSTS PRECEDENTIAL DECISIONS ON ITS WEBSITE

The Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB or the Board) has posted on its website precedential decisions issued by the Board during the years 1979 through 1994. These decisions were not previously available on the website. The Board will eventually make all of its opinions and orders issued prior to 1994 available (decisions issued since 1994 have been on the website for some time), but this task will take additional time to complete. Board customers are now able to take full advantage of technology and may locate complete text versions of pre-1994 important decisions in Federal personnel law, which are frequently cited by practitioners and the courts.
