The MSPB is an independent, quasi-judicial agency with responsibility for deciding Federal employee appeals from personnel actions taken against them and for protecting the integrity of the civil service and other Federal merit systems. The Board also conducts studies of the civil service and other merit systems in the Executive Branch and reviews significant actions of the Office of Personnel Management. The

Board, by law, is a bipartisan body composed of three Presidential appointees. In addition to Chairman Beth S. Slavet, the other current members of the Board are Vice Chairman Barbara J. Sapin and Member Susanne T. Marshall.
