THE MERIT SYSTEMS PROTECTION BOARD (MSPB) EXTENDS TIME FOR INTERESTED PARTIES TO FILE AMICUS BRIEFS

On April 16, 2010, the U.S. Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB) published a Notice in the *Federal Register* (See [75 FR 20007](#)) of the opportunity for interested parties to file amicus briefs in the matter of *Hyginus U. Aguzie v. Office of Personnel Management*, MSPB Docket Number DC-0731-09-0261-R-1.

The MSPB is providing Notice on Monday, May 24, in the *Federal Register*, advising the public of the new deadline for receiving amicus briefs of **June 7, 2010**.
