Tialino v. Merit Systems Protection Board, [No. 2016-1995](#) (Jan. 25, 2017) (MSPB Docket No. SF-0752-14-0513-I-2) (affirming the Board's dismissal of the appellant's involuntary resignation appeal for lack of jurisdiction because he failed to prove by preponderant evidence that he was misled about his retirement options, his resignation was coerced, or that the Department of the Army knew that it could not sustain the removal charges against him).
