COURT DECISIONS

NONPRECEDENTIAL:

Johnson v. Merit Systems Protection Board, [2017-1022](#) (June 9, 2017) (MSPB Docket No. DE-0353-16-0041-I-1) (affirming the Board's decision, which found that the appellant's involuntary retirement and restoration claims were barred by collateral estoppel).

Whittaker v. Department of Veterans Affairs, [2017-1656](#), (June 12, 2017) (MSPB Docket No. DA-0752-15-0157-I-1) (affirming the Board's dismissal, which found that the Board lacked jurisdiction over the appellant's removal pursuant to a last chance agreement in which she waived her appeal rights).

Nuri v. Merit Systems Protection Board, [2017-1462](#), (June 12, 2017) (MSPB Docket No. SF-1221-16-0293-W-1) (affirming the Board's dismissal, which found that the Board lacked jurisdiction over the agency's decision not to renew the appellant's term appointment as an adverse action appeal or as an individual right of action whistleblower reprisal appeal).

McDermott v. U.S. Postal Service, [2017-1258](#), (June 13, 2017) (MSPB Docket Nos. SF-3330-15-0432-I-1, SF-3330-15-0432-I-2) (affirming the Board's decision, which denied the appellant's request for corrective action under the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act of 1994).
