On October 13, 2017, the court [granted](#) the respondent's petition for rehearing en banc and vacated the [panel decision](#) reversing the agency's removal action on due process grounds. On May 14, 2018, by per curiam order, the court dissolved the en banc court and referred the case to the original panel for further proceedings.
