NONPRECEDENTIAL COURT DECISION

Yandoc v. Office of Personnel Management, [No. 2018-2302](#) (Fed. Cir. Feb. 6, 2018) (MSPB Docket No. SF-0831-18-0341-I-1): The court affirmed the administrative judge's decision affirming the Office of Personnel Management's denial of the appellant's request for a Civil Service Retirement System survivor annuity based on the Federal service of her late husband. The court agreed that the service of the appellant's late husband was not "covered" service subject to the Civil Service Reform Act and, thus, that the appellant was not entitled to a survivor annuity based on such service.
