NONPRECEDENTIAL COURT DECISION

Gonzalez-Pagan v. Merit Systems Protection Board, [No. 2018-1572](#) (Fed. Cir. May 15, 2019) (MSPB Docket No. NY-4324-17-0161-I-1): The court affirmed, per Rule 36, the administrative judge's initial decision dismissing for lack of jurisdiction the appellant's Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act appeal on the ground that he failed to nonfrivolously allege that his military service was a substantial or motivating factor in his nonselection.
