#### **NONPRECEDENTIAL COURT DECISION**

*Eclarin v. Office of Personnel Management*, No. [2018-2425](#) (Fed. Cir. June 5, 2019) (MSPB Docket No. SF-0831-17-0672-I-1): The court affirmed the Board's decision, which affirmed OPM's determination that the appellant was not entitled to a Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS) annuity. Although the appellant worked for the Department of Navy between 1957 and 1963 in Subic Bay, Philippines, he served in an indefinite appointment that was not covered by the CSRS.
