NONPRECEDENTIAL COURT DECISIONS

McGinn v. Department of Homeland Security, No. [2018-1414](#) (Fed. Cir. Sept. 6, 2019) (MSPB Docket No. DC-1221-16-0879-W-1): The court affirmed, per rule 36 judgement, the administrative judge's initial decision denying the appellant's request for corrective action in her individual right of action appeal.

Awe v. Merit Systems Protection Board, No. [2019-1058](#) (Fed. Cir. Sept. 10, 2019) (MSPB Docket No. CH-315H-18-0384-I-1): The court affirmed, per rule 36 judgement, the administrative judge's initial decision dismissing the appellant's probationary termination appeal for lack of jurisdiction.
