NONPRECEDENTIAL COURT DECISION

Eluhu v. Department of Veterans Affairs, No. [18-4243](#) (6th Cir. Feb. 24, 2020) (MSPB Docket No. AT-1221-18-0237-W-1): The court affirmed the administrative judge's finding that the appellant did not prove that the February 6, 2017 letter was a contributing factor in the agency's decision to remove him because the appellant failed to provide evidence that the proposing or deciding officials knew about the letter.
