NONPRECEDENTIAL COURT DECISIONS

Reynolds v. Merit Systems Protection Board, No. [20-2021](#) (Fed. Cir. Mar. 15, 2021): The administrative judge granted the Office of Personnel Management's motion to dismiss the appeal as untimely filed without a showing of good cause for the delay. On review, the court noted that Ms. Reynolds filed her Board appeal 9 months late and she never responded to the Board's timeliness order requiring her to file evidence or argument showing good cause. The court held that the Board did not abuse its discretion in dismissing Ms. Reynolds's untimely appeal.
