6 Tips for a Successful Probationary Period

Executive Order 14284, *Strengthening Probationary Periods in the Federal Service*, directs agencies to affirmatively certify continued employment would benefit the Federal service.

MSPB research provides tips for agencies to support probationers during and after this period.

Notify Applicants

Job candidates need to understand probationary requirements **before** they accept a federal position.



Establish Clear Expectations

Probationers need to understand what to do to succeed and the consequences for failing.



Set Performance Benchmarks

Agencies should discuss performance standards and set clear benchmarks for meeting them.



Provide Training

Agencies should provide relevant training during and after on-boarding.



Provide Feedback

Supervisors should regularly communicate with probationers about their performance.



Track Performance

Supervisors should document performance throughout the period to inform final decisions.
