ORDER

This case is before the Board on a Recommendation for enforcement dated March 6, 1990, by the Board's Dallas Regional Office, finding the agency in noncompliance with a settlement agreement. The case was referred to the full Board for enforcement, and an order instructing the agency to comply or to file a brief supporting its disagreement was issued. 5 C.F.R. § 1201.183(a)(6) (1990). On March 28, 1990, the agency

submitted evidence that it had complied with the order. The appellant has not exercised his regulatory right to respond to the agency submission, 5 C.F.R. § 1201.183(a)(7) (1990), although he was informed of this right in the recommendation.

Accordingly, in light of the apparent agency compliance and the appellant's failure to object to the agency's evidence of compliance, the Board hereby DISMISSES appellant's petition for enforcement. This is the final order of the Merit Systems Protection Board in this case.


