



Policy Governing Bookmarking Pleadings Submitted using e-Appeal

All pleadings submitted using e-Appeal must comply with the Board’s regulations at 5 C.F.R. § 1201.14. Electronic bookmarks in e-Appeal take the place of physical “tabs” in pleadings filed by traditional means. E-filed pleadings must contain bookmarks for all supporting documents, and the bookmarks must include information such as a brief descriptive label with dates (e.g., “Oct. 1, 2025 – Decision Notice”). Bookmarks may be specified using e-Appeal’s bookmarking functionality or by uploading the supporting documents in the form of one or more PDF files that are already bookmarked. 5 C.F.R. § 1201.14(h)(2).

Regardless of whether it is uploaded or entered online, each pleading submitted using e-Appeal will be assembled into a single PDF document, which will include all electronic attachments, and will contain sequential page numbers. E-filers need not manually paginate their pleadings and attachments.
